About the Event:

In a historic moment, India formally assumed the G20 Presidency, from Indonesia, on 01 December 2022. The G20, or Group of Twenty, is an intergovernmental forum of the world's 20 major developed and developing economies, making it the premier forum for international economic cooperation. It represents around 85% of the global GDP, over 75% of the worldwide trade, and about two-thirds of the world population.

The G-20 Presidency offers a unique opportunity for India to contribute to the global agenda on pressing issues of international importance.

On the occasion, the Prime Minister of India wrote an article outlining India's vision for the G20 Presidency. This was carried by publications across the world, including by The Yomiuri Shimbun and Japan News in Japan. In his article, the Prime Minister said that India looks forward to a Presidency of healing, harmony and hope.

During the G-20 Presidency, India will hold about 200 meetings in different sectors in multiple locations across India. Guests will experience India's diversity, inclusive tradition and cultural richness during the meetings.

The event's objective is to introduce the audience to theme, priorities and other aspects of India's G20 Presidency. The event will be inaugurated by H.E. Mr Sibi George, Ambassador of India to Japan.
